## PROCLAMATION UNDER THE ROADS AND JETTIES ACT 1935

### STATUTORY RULES 2024, No. 7

I, the Governor in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, by this my proclamation made under section 52A of the *Roads and Jetties Act 1935* –

- (a) declare the part of the Midland Highway specified in Schedule 1 to this proclamation to be a limited access road; and
- (b) set forth the places of access for that limited access road, for the purposes of section 52B of the *Roads and Jetties Act* 1935, in Schedule 2 to this proclamation; and
- (c) declare that this proclamation takes effect on the day on which its making is notified in the *Gazette*.
